



## Quick Suburb Guide

The Perth metropolitan area is long and narrow, tightly hugging the Indian Ocean coast line. All Perth suburbs are within 20 minutes of the beach!

The beautiful **Perth city centre** is the shopping, entertainment and business hub of the metropolitan area. The city area boasts a wide array of excellent value accommodation including hotels, apartments, bunkhouses and resorts.

The inner city suburb of **East Perth** is just a couple of city blocks back from the Perth CBD, and over recent years has undergone a renaissance, boasting some eye-catching new architecture. It is centred around the beautiful Claisebrook Inlet, part of the Swan River system. A free circular city bus operates to the CBD and Northbridge.

**Northbridge** is the main city entertainment district, right next to the Perth CBD. This busy area offers street after street lined with cafes, restaurants, bars and night clubs. Yet you will also find peaceful parks and plenty of trees. A free circular city bus operates from Northbridge to the CBD areas, East Perth and West Perth.

**Subiaco** is a sophisticated inner city suburb with a "village" like feel and is home to plenty of cafes, restaurants, boutique shops, bars and night clubs and the famous Australian Rules football ground. It is just a few minutes from the CBD, heading towards the beaches, with the railway line providing rapid connection to the CBD.

The famous port city of **Fremantle** is just 20 minutes from the Perth CBD and Scarborough Beach. Fremantle, boasts spectacular colonial architecture, vibrant restaurant and cafe lined streets and an energetically colourful market. Fremantle is famed for a somewhat bohemian atmosphere and a rich maritime history, Perth CBD, Northbridge, Cottesloe Beach, Claremont, Subiaco and Fremantle are easily accessible by the rail system.

The beach suburbs of **Scarborough Beach, Sorrento Beach, North Beach** and **Hillaries** are all along a stretch of Indian Ocean coast connected by the spectacular West Coast Highway. Scarborough Beach is just 20 minutes from the city and 15 minutes from the Tournament Venue.

**South Perth** and **Como** are just across the beautiful Swan River from the city. Enjoy the city skyline and more resort vibe of these exclusive river-front suburbs. A ferry connects South Perth with the city. The freeway provides for rapid travel across the Swan River and through the city en route to the Tournament Venue.
